Paper Submission Instructions

Adcons-2011 invites authors to submit original and unpublished work. Please submit full paper (10 pages maximum, CRC will be 6 pages) in Springer LNCS format. There will be short papers (CRC will be 4 pages) and poster papers (CRC will be 2 pages) presentations too, in addition to full-length paper. The manuscripts should be prepared in the style of Springer Verlag LNCS series (http://www.springer.com/computer/lncs?SGWID=0-164-6-793341-0).

All submitted papers will undergo a rigorous review process managed by the technical program committee. Authors should submit full / short papers or posters electronically (PDF files only). At least one author of each accepted paper must register, attend the conference and present the paper. The Conference Proceedings of Adcons-2011will be published by Springer in the Lecture Notes in Computer Science(LNCS) series. Complete paper submission instructions will be available at the conference website.

Pre-Conference Tutorials: Proposals are solicited for tutorials. Interested individuals/groups should submit a proposal by September 09, 2011 to the Tutorials Chair. The proposal (5 pages maximum) should include a brief description of the intended audience, a lecture outline, and a vita for each lecturer. For more details, please see the website.
